

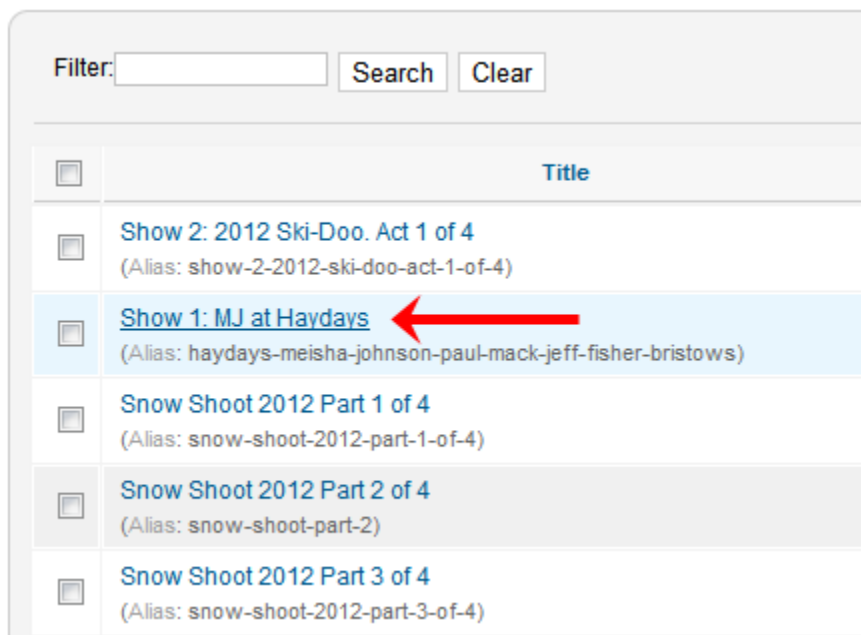
## Adding Video on the home page:

This article assumes you are using the RokBox plugin to display video on the home page of your site.

Once you login to the administration site, click on the Article Manager icon.

When the Article Manager page comes up, find the "Select Category" dropdown menu above the article list on the right side of the page. In that dropdown, select the "Slideshow ONLY" category. This will display only the Home-page video stories.

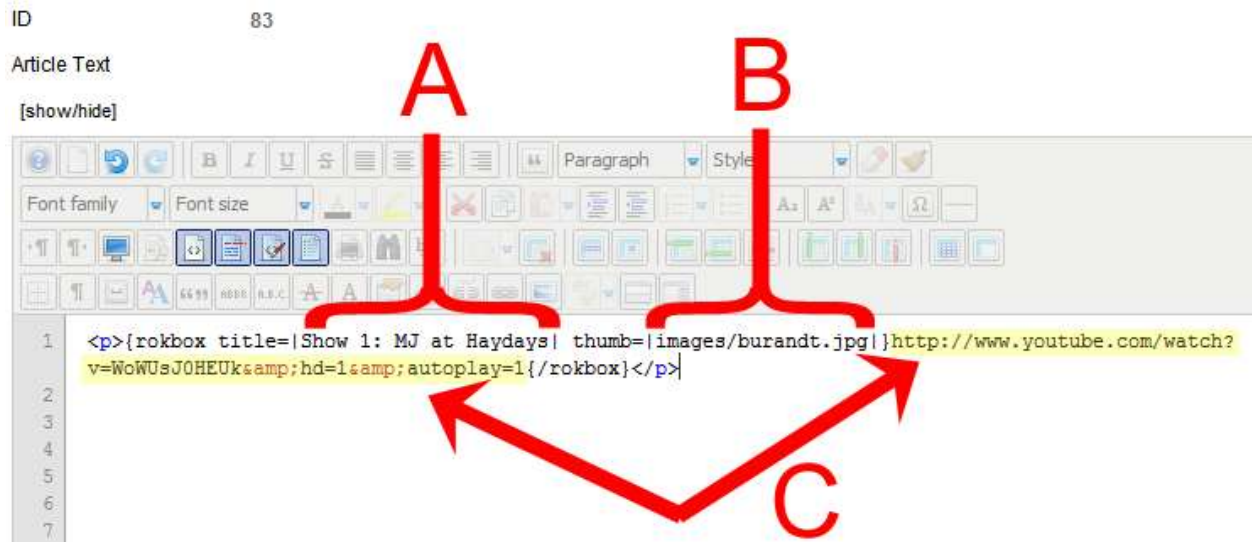
To edit a current item, click on its Title.



This will bring up the article edit screen. To make editing easier, click on the "Toggle Source Code" icon. This is important to ensure that the text you write is as you intend it to be.



Now you should see text similar to this in the Article Text box:



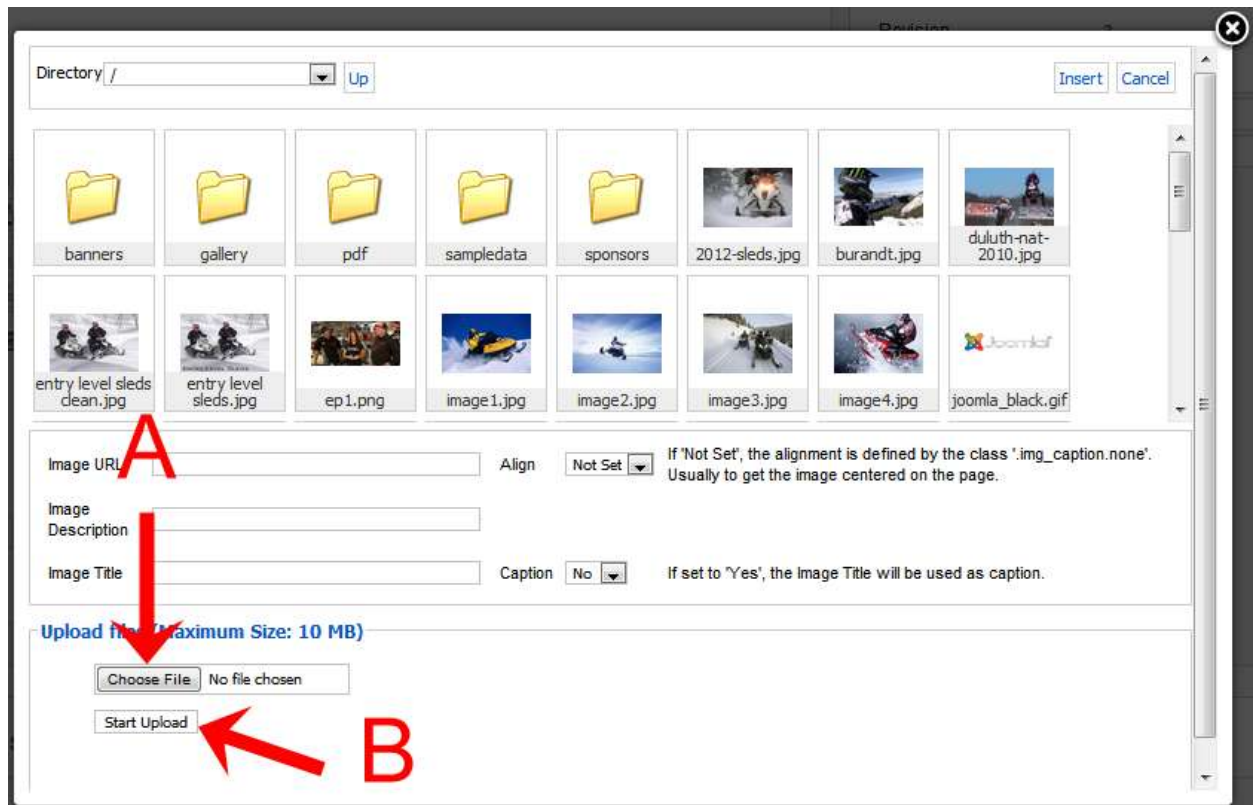
A. Is the title which will appear at the bottom of the Video Window. Replace as you see fit.

B. Is the relative path to the thumbnail you would like to use for this video clip. The images used here should be a jpg, and be 270px x 180px to keep them from stretching or loading slow. More on how to upload images later.

C. Is the full URL to the YouTube video. This includes any parameters you wish to add. For this one, I have added `hd=1` (enabled HD video for this clip) and `autoplay=1` (automatically starts the video)

Once you have made these replacements, simply save the article.

Uploading an image is pretty simple. At the bottom of the Article Text box, there is a button labeled "Image". Clicking on it will bring up the image manager



A. Click the Choose File button to browse for your image.

B. Click the Start Upload button to upload your image.

C. Note the name of your file, and close the dialog by clicking on the "X" at the top right corner.

Your image is now successfully uploaded to the server, and ready to use in the steps listed above.
